- Renewable annually with minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA and continued full-time enrollment

- Be degree seeking and not a Distance Campus student

- Must complete all requirements for admission
- Applied to educational expenses at WOU for full-time study (12+ credits)
- Divided between 3 terms (fall, winter and spring) for one academic year
- Total award may not exceed the cost of tuition
- If tuition is fully paid for by an outside resource, may not be able to receive award
- Cannot be used for distance education, summer term, or study abroad
