Oregon Student ALL IN SUCCESS CENTER

Oregon's 17 community colleges are using the guided pathways framework to improve rates of college completion, transfer, and attainment of jobs with value in the labor market — and to achieve equity in those outcomes.

The Oregon Student Success Center (OSSC) supports colleges with services that address pathways planning, pathways implementation, and other issues essential for college's work. The Center gives each college support based on its current needs and goals. In addition, the Center facilitates peer mentoring so colleges learn from one other and collectively help students across the state. In fall 2017, every Oregon community college completed the Guided Pathways Scale of Adoption Assessment. Based on this assessment and a detailed application process, the Center determined which colleges should continue with guided pathways planning and which were ready to embark on intensive implementation work.

One Oregon college completed the AACC Pathways Project and is a mentor college. Over time, additional colleges will serve as mentor colleges.
