Oregon Rural Community College Consortium


Supported by the Oregon Student Success Center, the Oregon Rural Community Consortium started in 2012 as a pilot consortium model for Achieving the Dream. Originally composed of 8 rural Community Colleges, the group expanded and pivoted to a sustained focus on student success in rural colleges. Participating members include: Blue Mountain, Clatsop,Columbia Gorge, Klamath, Oregon Coast, Rogue, Southwestern, Tillamook Bay, Treasure Valley, and Umpqua. Past projects include: annual Summer Institutes, best practices of equitable and inclusive campuses, and inclusion and diversity. Current work is organized around <u>Oregon HB 2864</u>.
