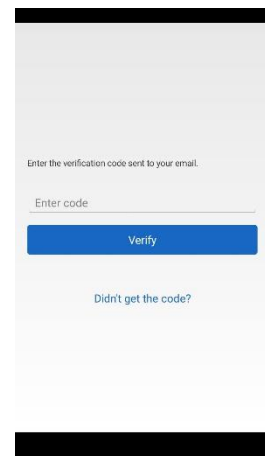


VoterVoice App Getting Started Instructions:

1. Download the VoterVoice app in the Google or Apple store, then open.
2. When you open the app, you'll want to enter your email and tap Log In when you see this page:



3. You'll then be sent a verification code to that email. Enter that code and click Verify when prompted on the screen:



4. You'll then be asked to Find Your Organization. Begin typing Oregon Community College Association until it automatically pops up for you to tap to select.



5. You'll then be taken to our Welcome page with our campaigns. You'll see our CTE Month campaign at the top. Tap on it to be taken to our Campaign page. Scroll to the bottom to Take Action in one of three ways!
