

Oregon's Community Colleges

2023 Community College Capital Construction Funding Request



Background

The Legislature authorizes community college capital construction projects funded with Article XI-G bonds funds up to \$8 million on a biennial basis. The Oregon Constitution requires colleges and universities to match Article XI-G bonds dollar-for-dollar. Because state bond funds are limited, HECC works with a group of college presidents to evaluate, and rank submitted capital construction projects in priority order for consideration by the Governor and Legislature each biennium. The HECC includes the ranked projects in their agency budget request. OCCA advocates for community college capital projects based on this collaborative ranking.
