## New Project Requests

- The Legislature authorizes Article XI-G funded community college capital projects up to \$8 million per college.
- Oregon Constitution requires colleges match these bonds dollar-for-dollar.
- HECC works with colleges to rank capital construction projects in priority order for consideration by the Governor and Legislature each biennium.
- Colleges may only request state funds every 4 years.

### Science, Math, Engineering Building Renovation

Renovates existing building on main campus that serves more than 5,800 students annually to address safety & compliance, and support growth of in-demand programs

### SUCCESS Project Building Remodels

Remodel three buildings to create expanded support and student success programs and services in a more accessible, collaborative & safe environment

### The Dalles/Hood River Facility Renovations

Ensure seismic resiliency and ADA compliance, expand hybrid learning opportunities, and install campus safety measures.

### Welcome Center & Medical Careers Training Hub

Replace existing facility that lacks functionality & accessibility; serve local healthcare industry with highly skilled workforce with 8 new medical careers programs

### Rock Creek Building 2 Complex

30,000-50,000 sq.ft. of CTE space for building construction technology & automotive collision and repair services
